Agricultural risks not only affect the farmers and their livelihood; they also affect the whole value chain right from Government, Financial Institutions (Banks / Insurers / Reinsurers), Intermediaries, Society and to the Farmers. Uncertainties in the Agriculture Market throws multiple challenges to all the stakeholders particularly the policy makers, insurers, reinsurers, intermediaries and farmers. The dynamics of Agriculture Insurance Market in India has drastically changed with the introduction of Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) scheme covering nearly 6 crore farmers. PMFBY has contributed Rs. 32500 crore premium (in 2019-2020) with more than 5 times of growth in few years. Crop insurance portfolio has now become the third largest portfolio contributing to 15% share, next to Motor and Health Insurance.

Policy level decisions by the Government and Regulators and the measures undertaken for successful implementation of insurance schemes at country level, plays crucial role in ensuring conducive environment for delivering the intended benefits of the schemes to the farmers to a maximum possible level meeting their crop losses which also in turn minimizes the gap between the insured benefits and the actual financial losses arising out of natural catastrophic events like droughts, floods, storms, etc. Apart from the policy level directives, the conscious and a well-integrated efforts by all the key stakeholders i.e. Government, Regulators, Insurers, Reinsurers, Brokers and other Service Providers, etc., in identifying the issues and the challenges in scaling up of insurance developments and their interventions to improve the penetration would play crucial role in benefiting the farmers greatly.

Realizing the above importance of the subject, National Insurance Academy is happy to bring out a professional certification course in Proficiency in Crop Insurance.



Objective

The main objective of the course is to provide knowledge about the main features of PMFBY Scheme and the Crop Cutting Experiments and Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (WBCIS). The course covers the claims settlement process and loss assessment methods used for widespread calamities, sowing failure / prevented sowing, localized calamities and post-harvest losses. The course also discusses the applications of technology in underwriting and loss assessment and types of methods of reinsurance arrangements for Agriculture Reinsurance in India.



Who should attend?

This course is ideally useful to all those people working in Agriculture Insurance, particularly, Insurance Executives, Officers and Field staff working in agriculture and revenue department of State Government, professionals associated with Crop Insurance, including Crop Surveyors, Loss Adjustors, field staff involved in CCE, Intermediaries and InsurTech and AgriTech companies, etc.



Course Structure

This course can be viewed on a Desktop, Tablet and Mobile devices. This on-line course comprises of 7 chapters with a quiz at the end of each chapter. Participant has to read / view all the 7 chapters thoroughly which will entitle him for a course completion certificate which is a pre-requisite for the final examination.

An on-line examination (MCQ based) would be organized once in every 3 months. Duration of the examination is 60 minutes with maximum of 70 questions to be answered.
