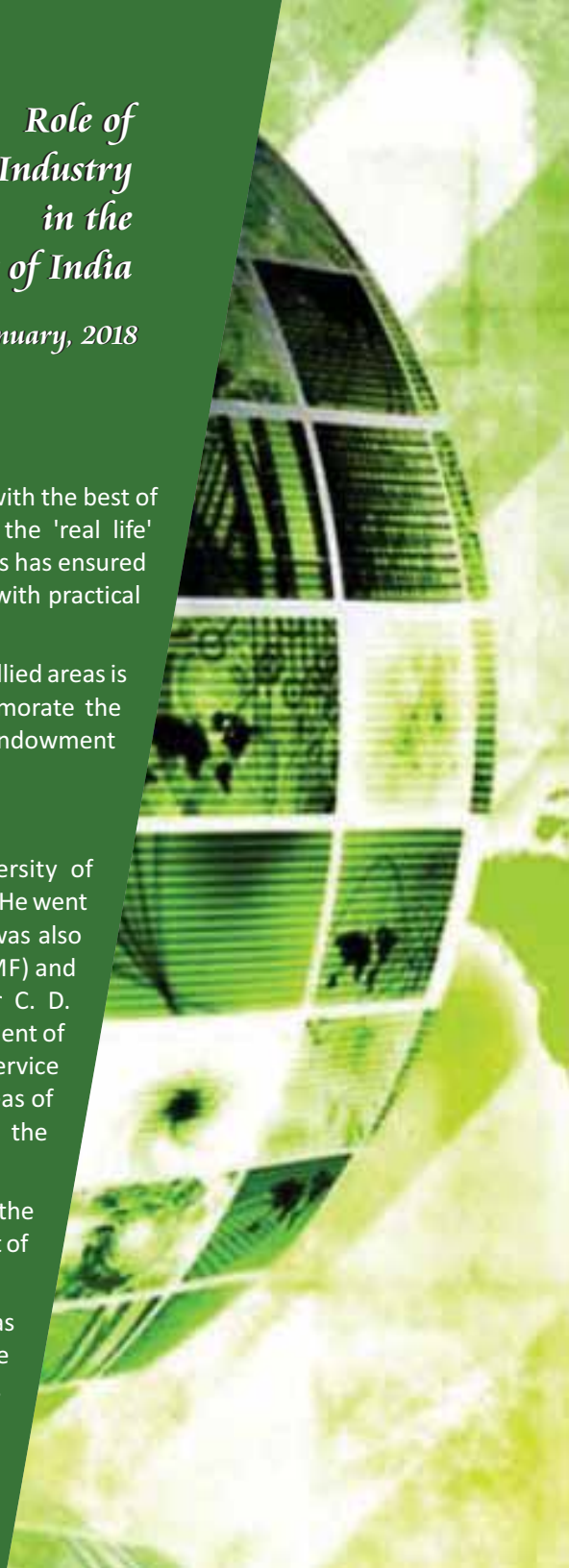
Sir Chintamanrao Dwarakanath Deshmukh (1896 - 1982)

Sir Chintamanrao Dwarakanath Deshmukh graduated from the University of Cambridge in 1917 and topped the Indian Civil Service Examination in 1918. He went on to be the Governor of the Reserve Bank of India. Sir C. D. Deshmukh was also member of the Board of Governors of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and the International Bank of Reconstruction and Development (IBRD). Sir C. D. Deshmukh was Finance Minister of India from 1950 to 1956. He was a recipient of the Ramon Magsaysay Foundation's Award for Distinguished Government Service in 1959. Sir C. D. Deshmukh made most significant contributions in the areas of economics as well as education and he had a remarkable stint also as the representative of the people.

As Finance Minister of India, he took the momentous decision to nationalize the life insurance industry in India in January, 1956, leading to the establishment of the Life Insurance Corporation of India on 1st September, 1956.

Sir C. D. Deshmukh, in his autobiography, 'In the course of My Life', has written, 'When all about me is forgotten, I will be remembered as the Finance Minister of India who nationalized the life insurance business in the country'.

Through the Sir C. D. Deshmukh Memorial Seminar we remember with profound regard the contributions made by him and pay tribute to one of the greatest sons of India.
